- Assessments

- Individuals we service: physical, cognitive, etc.
- Device trial and selection
 - AT Device Demo
 - AT Device Loan=Pine Tree Society AT Device Inventory
- Training in the use of the device



Common Ground Understanding

- AT (IDEA, ADA, Section 504 of Rehab. Act)
 - AAC (dedicated vs non-dedicated)
- Private Insurance/MaineCare/Medicare (communication/medical necessity)
- MaineCare Waiver Sections
- MaineCare Sections 109 and 60/DME



Assessment of AT

- Feature Matching/SETT/HEAATS Frameworks
- Justification in all areas including fine and gross motor, access, cognition, language
- 4+ week trial (for communication of a dedicated device) and the Dr. must review eval and be in agreement, and have seen person within the last 6 months (documented) ***Other paperwork required
- 4+ week trial NOT required for Private Pay, Bureau of Rehabilitation Services (in most instances) and those covered by a waiver.

- -Communication books
- -Text/Writing


Simple voice-output devices Voice-output devices with levels

How to choose AT?

Goal: functional, effective, efficient communication

- User preference
- User-friendly, user/family/caregiver abilities and support
- Attention to the device
- Communicative intent
- Language skills: Breadth & depth of vocabulary
- Language syntax---can they put words together
- Navigational skills
- Representational understanding
- Literacy skills

More on AT Selection

- Object permanence--- knowing that within the device, words are in underlying layers
- Access method--- lots to help but if fatigue fast then lowtech may be better
- Behavior
- "Verbalish"--- those who just need a clarification tools, but don't want a different voice.
- Environments that AT will be used in
- · Tasks that the person will be engaged in

***it doesn't have to be just one, may be a mix of the above



Funding

- Health Insurances are learning that tablet devices can be an AAC device @ far less cost
- Limited insurance funding at this time for an open/non-dedicated device such as an iPad as an AAC
- Insurances are not funding "recreational" tool or extra warranties, or most ancillary items (i.e. carrying cases)
- State/Insurers are specific when it comes to funding paperwork requirements PineTree
